1. APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

Apologies for absence were received from Cllr. J. Harrison, Cllr. D. Gotts and PCSO E. Roberts.

3. MINUTES OF THE MEETING HELD ON MONDAY 15TH SEPTEMBER 2014

The Minutes of the meeting held on Monday 15th September 2014, having been circulated, were taken as read, **AGREED** and signed by the Chairman,.

4. LIVING ON THE EDGE FUNDING

4.1 The Clerk read an email received from Norfolk Coast Partnership stating that they had been unsuccessful with their Heritage Lottery Funding Landscapes Partnerships application "Living on the Edge". They will consider their next steps shortly. District Councillor Fitch-Tillett said it was very disappointing but they will try again with the application.

It was **AGREED** to suspend the meeting for public participation.

6.1 County Councillor's Report:- Attached. County Councillor Northam reported that he had received an email from a resident living in Middle Street asking whether he could be given permission to repair cars and park untaxed cars on the road. The resident then reported a neighbour for carrying out car repairs and parking untaxed vehicles in Middle Street. District Councillor Fitch-Tillett also received the email and referred the matter to Environmental Health at North Norfolk District Council. The officers have contacted the member of public and informed him of what he can and cannot do. The Members asked the County and District Councillors what the Parish Council can do about the increasing nuisance being caused by a resident of Middle Street. It was **AGREED** that the Chairman will speak to the member of public who has put in the complaint. County Councillor Northam will speak to the Police on behalf of the Parish Council and District Councillor Fitch-Tillett will refer it back to Environment Health at North Norfolk District Council and ask them to carry out a site visit.

6.3 Coastal Erosion:- The Chairman reported that Norman Lamb has requested a meeting with the Chief Executive of North Norfolk District Council with no response. The Parish Council requested District Councillor Fitch-Tillett to extend an invitation from them to the Chief Executive of North Norfolk District Council and County Councillor Seaward to a meeting with the Parish Council. District Councillor Fitch-Tillett said she would pass on the invitation. District Councillor Fitch-Tillett said that the Minister of State at DEFRA will be visiting the area in the New Year and will be invited to Trimingham. There is no firm date for the visit at present. District Councillor Fitch-Tillett will keep the Parish Council informed. The Chairman said it is very important that Trimingham has a voice and feels that the SMP needs to be changed and the revetments which were removed should be replaced.
